PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL:

1. Ms. Odessa Anthony addressed the Council to express appreciation on behalf of Our Lady of Victory Catholic Church for Parish assistance with the proposed donation of portable buildings from the Iberia Parish School Board to be used as food pantries. She explained that all portable buildings were retained by Shepherd's Food Pantry, as the two buildings that they were to donate to Our Lady of Victory were not large enough for the purposes being used. She expressed appreciation for the Council's attempt to assist the group.
2. Ms. Carol Whipp, Director for the Council on Aging, addressed the Council to provide an overview of the services offered to the public, including the sources of funding for all programs involved.
3. District 12 Councilman Charles Williams addressed the Council regarding the use of tax proceeds for Recreation District No. 8 over the past several years and expressed concern that now that the Board is aware that funding can be distributed for building improvements throughout the District, and not just the Ward 8 Building, funds are not being distributed fairly. He suggested that some of the remaining funding in the Recreation District No. 8 Budget should be used for other parks such as King Joseph Park.

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-09-4228

AN ORDINANCE OF THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL RECLASSIFYING PORTIONS OF THAT AREA ROUGHLY BOUNDED BY US 90/COLLEGE TOAD AND OLIVIER ROAD FROM MIXED RESIDENTIAL (R-2) TO GENERAL BUSINESS (C-2) LOCATED IN DISTRICT 12, AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 2009-02-4099, adopted February 25, 2009, established Zoning Regulations for rural Iberia Parish and is recorded in the Official Records of Iberia Parish at COB 1430, Page 65.

SECTION 2: At that time that the Zoning Ordinance and Map was adopted, the area shown on the attached map and described above was zoned mixed Residential (R-2) even though there were two (2) commercial establishments located within the area.

SECTION 3: The two (2) commercial establishments are Mon Ami (located at the intersection of US 90 and College Road), and a vacant paint and automobile body shop (located off US 90) on Jeanminette Road.

SECTION 4: The Legal Description of the Mon Ami property is:

That certain lot or parcel of ground, together with all of the buildings and improvements thereon and all rights, ways, privileges and servitudes thereto belonging, situated in the Second (formerly First) Ward of Iberia Parish, Louisiana in Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 7 East, being irregular in shape, containing and measuring one hundred seventy feet (170'), more or less, on the south side of U.S. Highway 90 (Louisiana Highway 3052 during construction) by a depth on its easterly boundary of two hundred thirty feet (230'), more or less, measuring to its southern boundary two hundred seventy feet (270'), more or less, and a depth on its Westerly boundary of one hundred thirteen feet (113'), more or less, being bounded on the North by U.S. Highway 90, on the South by Olivier, East by property of Jas. Ledet and West in part by of Joseph A. Olivier, et ux and in part by College Road.

That certain lot or parcel of ground, situated in the First Ward of Iberia Parish, Louisiana in Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 7 East, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon and thereunto belonging, and all rights, ways, privileges, and servitudes in anywise appertaining, containing and measuring one hundred nine feet (109') front on the South side of Louisiana State Highway 3052 (Four Lane highway), the western boundary of said lot having a depth in a southerly direction along College Road of one hundred twenty feet (120'), the eastern boundary converging toward the rear of said lot to give a total width along the rear of southern boundary of seventy feet (70'), being bounded on the South and

East by Joseph Olivier, on the North by Louisiana State Highway 3052 and West by College Road.

Being the same property acquired by the First National Bank of Jeanerette in a Dation En Paiement from Joseph Arthulo Olivier, et ux, recorded on the 12th day of May, 1988 at COB 946/88-3177 of the public records of Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

SECTION 5: The vacant paint and automobile body shop is 2602 Jeanminette Road.

SECTION 6: In order to promote the continued commercial utilization of the facilities in the area as well as promote further commercialization along the US 90 corridor, the two (2) commercial facilities should be reclassified from Mixed Residential (R-2) to General Business (C-2) and the remaining area should remain zoned Mixed Residential (R-2).

SECTION 7: That the Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CHANNEL L-2D-1B-1, LOCATED IN DISTRICT 13, WITH A 35' WIDTH ON EACH SIDE OF TOP BANK, FROM CREIGHTON DRIVE SOUTH FOR A DISTANCE OF 228', ALL AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, that in accordance with Chapter 20, Section 20-7, Easement for Drainage Canal, Levee, and Appurtenances, the following channels shall be established as part of the Watershed Program in Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, that witnesseth for and in consideration of the benefits and improvements to Grantors in adjoining lands derived from the operation and maintenance of the drainage project hereafter mentioned, Grantor hereby acknowledges and does hereby grant and convey unto the Parish of Iberia, his successors and assigns, the right, liberty, and authority to enter upon and to construct, operate, and maintain a drainage canal, levee, and appurtenances in, over, and upon the following channels, situated in the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana.
