WHEREAS, as the Iberia Parish Coroner serves as the oversight of this contract, it is suggested that the current contract be extended on a month-to-month basis for further discussion at a future meeting of the Finance Committee to determine if said contract can be extended until the position of Iberia Parish Coroner has been filled on a permanent basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby authorize the Parish President to execute the renewal of the contract for Ambulance Services for the Parish of Iberia with Acadian Ambulance on a month-to-month basis, which contract is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2010.

Chairman Jerome Fitch recognized Parish President Ernest Freyou to speak. Mr. Freyou stated that he would like to give an update on the Jail Security System. Mr. Freyou recognized Mr. Ted Habetz of Berard, Habetz & Associates to speak on the details of the Security System. Mr. Habetz explained that proposals have been obtained with a low proposal of \$556,000, which is much lower than the original projected cost. The project is expected to take approximately five to six months for installation, with a one year warranty and service agreement with 24 hour call. The additional annual cost for the service agreement is expected to be approximately \$22,000 per year.

## **COUNCIL MEMBER/STAFF ANNOUNCEMENTS**

1. Mr. Boudoin questioned the status of the construction of additional parking for the Courthouse and was advised that work would begin in January.
2. Mr. Brown questioned the status of the solid waste bids process and was advised that a pre-bid conference was held with the bid opening date being change to January 12<sup>th</sup> due to the addition of addendums.
3. Mr. Broussard announced a Finance Committee meeting to be held on January 19<sup>th</sup> to discuss the Public Works Department budgets, severance tax revenues, etc.
4. Ms. Daniels questioned the status of the renewal of health insurance and was advised that this process will begin within 60 days.
5. Mr. Williams pointed out to the Council members a request that will be discussed in the near future regarding possible change orders for the Recreation District No. 8 Building Renovations Project.
6. Assistant District Attorney Eric Duplantis expressed concern regarding a proposal to reduce the Council's size as this is a reapportionment year and he is concerned that a plan for reapportionment will only have a short review and approval period prior to qualifying for the October elections. He suggested that if the Council chooses to propose a reduction in the number of Council districts, it may delay the time involved in the review process, which could delay the October elections.
